NOTICE OF TEMPORARY USE

Temporary Use Permit
1859 Durfee Avenue

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Department has received an application for a Temporary Use Permit to allow for a Circus Land Use (Circo Caballero) with circus performances under a temporary tent structure designed to accommodate a circus use with and up to 300 patrons. The proposal will also include an outdoor food concession stand. The proposed circus will perform an acrobatic show; no live animals will be performing as part of the show. The proposed circus will have daily shows at 7:30 p.m. each day with additional shows on the weekends and will run between June 17, 2021 through June 28, 2021, providing a total of 18 shows at two hours long. The above-mentioned concession stands will be open during the event at all times, no sales of alcohol are being proposed.

As part of the operations, the Circus will provide security personnel that will be present prior to the first event and will be at least one half hour after the conclusion of the last show. Parking will be provided around the corner at Monte Vista Elementary School located at 11111 Thienes Avenue. As part of the approval, the surrounding area and parking lots will be cleaned from any trash generated by the event as required under the Temporary Use Permit.
