

ORDINANCE NO. 1153

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SOUTH EL MONTE INCREASING THE NUMBER OF COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMISSIONERS FROM SEVEN TO NINE COMMISSIONERS AND ESTABLISHING A TERM OF ONE YEAR FOR ALL COMMISSIONS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH EL MONTE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1: Section 2.48.020 of Title 2 (Administration & Personnel) of the South El Monte Municipal Code regarding membership of the community services commission is hereby amended to read as follows:

"2.48.020. Membership. The community services commission shall consist of nine city residents appointed by a majority of the city council, including two seniors 60 years of age or older and two youths between the ages of sixteen and twenty-five. The city council shall consider the nominations of the City's Senior Advisory Committee in appointing the senior members. No City employee is eligible to serve as a member of the commission. No person shall remain a member if that person ceases being a resident of the city. The term of office for members shall be one year. Notwithstanding the foregoing, a member shall continue to serve until a qualified successor assumes that member's seat. If a vacancy occurs during the term, the council shall appoint a qualified successor to serve the remainder of the term. A majority of the council may remove a member at any council meeting."


Section 2: The term of office for members of all City commissions shall be one year.

Section 3: The City Council hereby directs the City Clerk to revise the City's Municipal Code so that the term of office for members of all City commissions is one year.


Section 4: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance.


