

RESOLUTION NO. 23-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH EL MONTE CITY COUNCIL
FIXING THE AMOUNTS AND CONDITIONS OF COMPENSATION
FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF WOMEN & GIRLS COMMISSION

RECITALS

A. The City of South El Monte takes its stewardship over the use of its limited public resources seriously. Periodically, the City Council has adopted ordinances and resolutions relating to expenses actually and necessarily incurred by public officials in connection with their official duties on City business.

B. A number of residents volunteer their time to participate in City government as advisory commissioners advising the Council on all matters pertaining to the advancement of women and girls. The City Council would like to reimburse such residents for the time spent attending meetings and other City activities.

C. This policy satisfies the requirements of Gov't Code §§ 53232.2 and 53233.3, supplements the definition of actual and necessary expenses for purposes of state law relating to permissible uses of public resources by Commissioners.


NOW THEREFORE, THE SOUTH EL MONTE CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes to pay each Commissioner a \$100 stipend for each meeting the Commissioner attends quarterly.


