The Commission wanted both members to remain on the board, but the only way it was possible was if they were honorary. Commissioner Figueroa asked when it was appropriate to wear their badges. Chairperson stated that the badges should be worn during meetings, and City sponsored events. Commissioner Figueroa asked who they call if they are not able to attend the meeting. Miss Saucedo stated that they can call her.

9. COMMISSION COMMENTS:

Commissioner Figueroa asked what fundraisers have the Commission had besides the dance. It was stated that the Commission has sold military items at the 4th of July event and at the Memorial Day Ceremony. It was also stated that they have sold pepper bellies and nachos at the Cinco de May Celebration and the Concert series. It was discussed that the Commission will be selling aguas frescas at the upcoming Cinco de Mayo event. Chairperson Hennings would like to know if they can sell sodas and waters at the Cinco de Mayo event. Staff will have an answer at the next meeting.
